Maintenance. If your lights are damaged by the sun you can use toothpaste (or a dedicated product to polish them) to try to bring their original brightness back. But consider changing them if you are not able to get a pleasing result.

- **Fog light Covers:** These covers are great for preventing any unwanted scratches when the car is not in movement.
- **Regular Cleaning:** Use a microfiber cloth and a dedicated headlight cleaner to remove dirt, grime, and insect residue that can dull your lights over time.

Interior Harmony

A truly timeless T3 is a feast for the eyes, both inside and out. Keeping the interior clean and well-maintained adds to the overall experience and preserves its value.

- **Vacuum Regularly:** Invest in a handheld vacuum with various attachments to reach those nooks and crannies.
 - If you don't have a Vacuum (or if you are in a rush), use a little brush and your floor mat to clean the inside of your T3. Drag the dirt off the floor using the brush and the edge of the mat to pick it up as you go.

- **Protect Your Dash:** Sunlight not only fades your car's paint, but also damages your dashboard and plastic interiors over time. Protect your car's interior with a dedicated plastic protector atomizer, to maintain a bright, like-new finish. Apply it with a dry microfiber (never apply it directly).
- **Floor Mats:** Durable floor mats protect your T3's original flooring from dirt, spills, and wear. When these get dirty, clean them with the rest of the soap combination you used for to wash your T3.

These are the basics to taking care of your T3. Every time you wash your car, it's an opportunity to assess its current state.

What Model is My T3?

Step 1. Locate the Chassis Number.

The Chassis number on the T3 or Type 25 is in a few locations:

- On the Vin plate riveted to the A post
- On the rear face of the Offside Front Chassis Outrigger
- On the chassis sticker either above the pedals
- On your V5

Insert the VIN number in one of the following webpages.

1. EpicVin. Perfect to get a detailed report (stolen, accidents) if you pay. General specifications are available for free. Link: <https://epicvin.com/es>
2. Vindecoderz. Perfect to get few general details of your T3 (Free). Link: <https://www.vindecoderz.com/EN/Volkswagen>

How to Assess the Condition of Components.

Finding bargain T3 parts is a thrill, but nobody wants buyer's remorse! This guide helps you buy used with confidence:

- **The Walkaround:**
 - a. Overall Condition: Look for rust, dents, signs of poor repairs (mismatched paint, etc.).
 - b. Matching Your Needs: A part perfect for a "patina" project might not be right for a concours restoration.
- Close-Up Examination:
 - a. **Metal Parts: Check for:**
 - i. Rust: Surface rust might be okay, but structural rust is a major concern.
 - ii. Cracks/Bends: Especially on suspension parts or anything safety critical.

iii. Wear Patterns: On moving parts, uneven wear indicates potential issues.

b. Rubber/Plastic Parts:

- i. Cracking/Dry Rot: Especially on hoses, belts, seals - these are often overlooked!
- ii. Flexibility: Rubber should be pliable, not brittle.
- iii. Functional Testing (If Possible):

c. Electrical: Ask to see lights, switches, motors, etc., working.

- i. Moving Parts: Can you manually operate levers, linkages, or test fit the part?
